## TESTING INFORMATION

High Country Christian Academy (HCCA) will open achievement testing registration January 2, 2024. Registration will be available through March 15, 2024. Registration is required to test. The registration link is located on the Academy webpage, under STANDARDIZED TESTING. Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. There will be a limited number of students per grade. If a grade you would like to test a student in is full, we will contact you to discuss. No registrations or changes will be accepted after March 15, 2024.

**WHEN:** The dates of testing for 2024 are Tuesday and Wednesday, May 7 and 8, 2024. Attendance both days is required. Please arrive at 8:45 AM to check-in. Testing will end at approximately 12:30 PM each day. Students must stay for the duration of the test. No early dismissals.

**WHERE:** Testing will be held at New Life Church 11025 Voyager Parkway, Colorado Springs, CO 80921

**WHAT:** HCCA administers the Terra Nova II for 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th, and 11th grades. This is a nationally standardized test that meets the Colorado Homeschool statute requirements. The test covers the following: reading, word analysis, vocabulary, language usage and mechanics, spelling, math computation, math problem solving and concepts, science, and social studies.

**COST:** The cost of testing is \$50 per student. It is payable online at the completion of the testing registration form. No refunds will be made after March 15, 2024. Refunds before March 15, 2024 are subject to a 7.6% fee.

**RESULTS:** Test scores will be mailed within 6-8 weeks after testing. Test scores given to parents will include the raw score, grade equivalent, percentile ranking, and a narrative report explaining highlights of results.

**PLEASE NOTE:** HCCA is unable to accommodate testing children with special needs. There are no refunds of testing fees if your child cannot attend testing on the scheduled days due to illness or family conflicts.
