




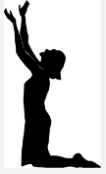

## OPEN HCEC LEADERSHIP POSITIONS

Would you like to serve at High Country? Do you have a heart for ministering to other homeschoolers? Then c'mon and join our team! Living in a military community, we often have Military Transfers. Sadly, we are saying goodbye to a few at the end of this semester and will miss these ladies tremendously! We are currently looking to fill the following positions:



**Program Support Coordinator:** Do you have the gift of helping? Would you like to be instrumental in the safety and smooth running of High Country? In this position, you will manage and train the Vital Partners that serve in Program Support, working closely with other members of the Operations Team. Each class day requires a coordinator to bless our school community. Position averages 10 hours a week.

**Operations Manager:** This individual will have a desire to serve in a support role to the Administrator and the Operations Director with the ability to make decisions in their absence. Fostering a vital relationship with New Life Church Facilities and High Country families, as well as overseeing the Vital Partner, Security, and Operations program are primary ministry focuses of this position. Excellent interpersonal communication and computer skills are a plus.

**Wednesday Lunch Program Coordinator:** This position has the opportunity to do face-to-face ministry with our families at High Country. Most all of our families eat something sometimes from our lunch program, so meeting and serving them is a fun part of the Coordinator's job. Two Coordinators work together to provide a quality lunch program for everyone and oversee the volunteers, who consist of both adults and youth. Blessing each of our volunteers through loving oversight is an added treat for our servant leader. The average time requirement is 10 - 15 hours per week during each semester.
